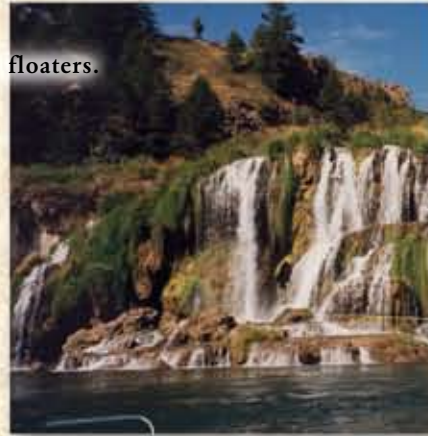




Fall Creek Falls presents a great photo op for floaters.

Wild flowers abound along hiking trails.

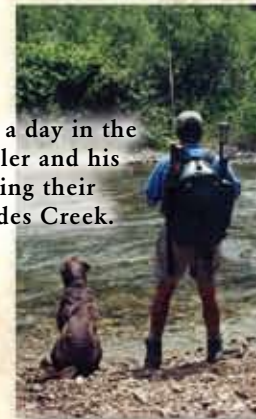
Kids also land their share of big ones.
